**From Route 495:** Exit 32 onto Boston Road heading west (from Southbound, take a right. From Northbound go left.) When the road ends at Westford Village green, take a left. Take your second right onto Graniteville Road. After you cross the railroad bridge, take an immediate left on Broadway Street. Waggin' Tail will be on the right in a small industrial park.

**From Route 3:** Exit 33, take a left onto MA 40/Groton Road. At 3.6 miles, take a slight left for North Street (signs for Forge Village). Continue onto North Main Street. Take a left onto Broadway. Waggin' Tails will be on your left.

## Facility & Food

Doors will open at 7:30am. Please don't arrive before this time.

There is plenty of indoor crating space. The main crating area is up a short flight of stairs. If this will present a problem to you, please let us know that you will require crating space on the main level. (There are no stairs to get into the building.)

**Run order will be Obedience – Utility, Open, Novice, Subnovice for both Trials.**

**Rally run order will be Level 1,2,3 for Trial 1 and Level 3,2,1 for Trial 2.**

## ENTRY CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

1. ENTRY cancellations MUST be received in writing prior to the closing of entries or before limits have been reached. Requests MUST INCLUDE dog's UKC NUMBER, breed, name, and event type. Cancellations received by telephone will not be accepted.
2. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled AFTER the closing date and time, except in the cases of females that come into season and are entered in Obedience, Rally Obedience, or Weight Pull events. In those cases, refunds may be obtained by providing the host club with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the female came into season after the closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the event, or delivered by hand to the host club's superintendent personnel before the start of the event.
3. Cancelled entries submitted before the close of entries will be charged a \$10 processing fee. No entries will be refunded after the closing date and time or after entry limits have been reached.
4. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
5. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
6. Entry overpayments may be donated to the general prize fund.
7. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization, it is impossible to open or to complete an event, no refund of entry fee will be made.
8. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, tornado, lightning or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop an event before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

## MOVE UP POLICY

- Dogs fulfilling the requirements for a UKC Obedience Title may move up to the next level of competition starting with the next trial even if they have not been notified by UKC.
- Neither UKC nor United Dog Sports of Northern New England dog club will be responsible for any mistakes made by the dog's owner concerning points or legs.
- If you wish to move up to the next level of competition, please notify the entry table prior to the end of that day's trial.

## SUBSTITUTION POLICY

Substitution of a dog(s) will not be allowed.
